NOTICE

NB Power has applied to the New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board for the following:

- 1. An Order, pursuant to subsection 107(2) of the *Electricity Act*, approving three capital projects more particularly described as follows:
 - a. a transmission capital project known as the Saint John Corridor Reinforcement Project, consisting generally of the construction of two new 138 kV transmission lines from the terminal at the Coleson Cove Generating Station to a point on the transmission system near Fairvale, New Brunswick, a distance of approximately 32 kilometers of line, together with related transmission system changes to be more particularly described in NB Power's evidence, at a projected gross capital cost of \$116,198,822;
 - a transmission capital project known as the Coleson Cove Tie Transformer Project, consisting generally of the procurement and installation of 345 kV/138 kV tie transformer at the Coleson Cove Generating Station, at a projected gross capital cost of \$51,413,034; and
 - c. a transmission capital project known as the Dynamic Reactive Support (STATCOM) Project, consisting generally of the procurement and installation of a +/- 300 MVAR power electronic STATCOM device at Salisbury, New Brunswick at a projected gross capital cost of \$133,434,842;
- 2. In the alternative, an Order approving one or more of the capital projects on an individual basis;
- 3. Directions with respect to the schedule for the full hearing of this Application, and any other preliminary or procedural matters; and

4. Such other Orders and/or directions with respect to any other matters as the Board sees fit.
