



Canadian Navigable Waters Act

NB Power hereby gives notice that a submission has been added to the Common Project Search (online registry) pursuant to the *Canadian Navigable Waters Act* described herein for a 30-day public comment period.

Pursuant to paragraph 4.1 and 9.1 of the said Act, NB Power has deposited with the Minister of Transport, on the on-line Common Project Search Registry (<http://cps.canada.ca/>) and under registry numbers 15121 and 15123, a description of the following work:

The project involves construction of a 345 kV overhead electrical transmission line (Line L3226) forming part of the New Brunswick / Nova Scotia Interprovincial Transmission Line Project between the Salisbury Transmission Substation and Memramcook Transmission Substation in New Brunswick. A component of this project includes an overhead crossing of the Memramcook River at latitude: 46.170000 / longitude: -64.74000; in the vicinity of Centrale Street; and, Petitcodiac River at latitude: 46.008220 / longitude: -64.679300; in the vicinity of Principal Street.

The project will span the river without in-water works, maintain safe navigation conditions at all times, and provide long-term infrastructure supporting regional electrical reliability.
